Teach For All is working to launch a Global Institute to enable diverse classroom, school, and system leaders to learn together about how to develop all students—in particular those in the most marginalized communities—as leaders of a more just, equitable, and sustainable future.

The Global Institute is seeking faculty to design and co-lead sessions in the Global Academy pilot in 2025. To apply for the open positions as a faculty member, we invite you to fill out this <u>application form</u> with your relevant details and information. The deadline to apply to design or facilitate a course is <u>July</u> <u>21st</u>, <u>2024</u>. Please read the below in its entirety before applying.

About the Global Academy

One of the key pillars of the Global Institute will be an Academy that will foster collective learning among thousands of diverse practitioners to grow their collective leadership to transform classrooms, schools, and systems.

Structure

The Academy will run courses and workshops twice this year on a 6-month cycle, supporting both hemispheres. In each cycle, the academy will offer a series of courses and workshops that end with participants carrying out an action research project, which will be shared in a global showcase. The first cycle of implementation will be held from Feb - April and the second cycle will be held from June - September.

Courses and Workshops Offerings

The Academy will offer courses and workshops on topics of global interest, addressing the needs and interests of a diverse range of participants from all over the world. The courses will generally consist of 6 to 12 sessions over 2 months, finishing with the participants creating an action learning project. Workshops are smaller offerings with 1 to 3 sessions.

Audience

- **The network and beyond**: The Academy is an engine of innovation and learning designed to bring together people with a shared interest in the questions we will explore.
- **Practitioners:** The Academy's key audience is people actively working in classrooms, schools, organizations, or systems to help all students thrive. This might include teachers, school leaders, policymakers, social entrepreneurs, non-profit leaders, civil society leaders, researchers, donors, parents, or students.

Academy Pilot 2025

The Global Academy will be piloting operations in 2025 with an initial set of courses and workshops to enable the best experience for the participants, there are a few things that we are trying to test in the pilot as below:

- 1. **Leading the offering:** All the offerings will be co-led by at least 2 faculty members from diverse backgrounds. In case you are unable to get a co-lead, the Global Academy will support you in finding another person within the Teach for All global team to co-lead the offering with you.
- 2. **Connection with the purpose of Global Institute:** To ensure our courses are furthering our aims as a Global Institute, our selection of courses will consider how the offering is related to the overall purpose and orientation of the Global Institute. Application for a faculty member at Global Institute

To apply for the open positions as a faculty member, we invite you to fill out this <u>application form</u> with your relevant details and information.

The deadline to apply to design or facilitate a course is <u>July 21, 2024</u>, and the applicants will learn whether they were selected as faculty by <u>August 12th, 2024</u>. The selection committee that reviews applications will focus on:

- The extent to which proposed faculty have firsthand experience as practitioners in the topic they will facilitate
- The experience of the proposed faculty in facilitating adult learning in a constructivist manner to foster discovery-oriented and relational learning
- The extent to which the proposed faculty can enrich the balance in content between local and global perspectives (We highly encourage faculty to apply in pairs with people coming from at least two different countries/contexts)
- The ways in which the proposed approach to the offering design and implementation reflects both our network values and commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion
- The extent to which the proposed content will be practical, engaging for participants, and contribute to our broader action research agenda.

The selection committee will also seek a balance of offerings across regions, languages, and topics.

• Faculty Commitment:

We expect the faculty to comply with our values as a network including Child Safety and our Network Policies. We expect the faculty to be open to receiving feedback and working with the Academy team in full cooperation.

We also expect the faculty to fully participate and engage in the activities of the Academy, including the faculty training sessions. Adherence to timelines is critical to enable the best experience for our participants. Faculty are expected to engage in the following activities:

Note: Apart from the dates of the milestones mentioned above, there will be a requirement of working with the Academy team to take feedback into account, prepare for the logistics of sessions, etc.

- **Faculty Support:** The Academy team would provide continuous support to the faculty in designing and delivering their offering. It would also provide the faculty with a community of a diverse group of like-minded people.
 - **Faculty Training:** There will be a dedicated series of training sessions for the faculty focusing on an introduction to Global Institute, guidance on designing a learner-oriented offering, and means of accessing the support that the Academy team would offer. This would be held in August, between 26th and 31st August 2024.
 - **Faculty Ongoing Support:** On an ongoing basis, the head of faculty excellence will provide office hours for support, which can be taken up by the potential faculty members. The Academy team would also provide operations, systems, and logistics support to the faculty members, though that support will require the timely sharing of relevant information by the faculty.
 - Selection of participants: The Academy team will support in selecting the participants for each offering based on selection criteria determined at the beginning. The first draft of the selected participants will be shared with the faculty before determining the final list of participants for each offering.

• Faculty Selection:

We welcome applications from former Teach For All network partner staff members, participants, alumni, and external individuals or organizations. Applicants must be at least 18 years old to apply.

Building on the aspiration to be globally informed, we encourage co-leads who can collectively enrich and diversify the learnings and offerings of a course or workshop. Additionally, we also welcome guest speakers who can bring specific insights into the course or workshop, especially to diversify and enrich the learning context and content.

In your application, please mention if you would like to bring a guest speaker for any section. We recommend that if the participation of a co-lead/guest speaker entails an honorarium, the additional expenses are to be included in the proposal for consideration.

For current Teach For All network partner staff members, we are not accepting applications from individual staff members, but organizations are welcome to apply and to determine which of their staff will contribute.

• Faculty Pay:

Courses

Compensation for courses is for a fixed lump sum paid in USD. While the exact number of hours may vary based on the individual, we have built these fixed rates assuming that course design requires approximately 25 hours and that course facilitation requires 25 hours of work and have determined the rates based on local market benchmarks.

We expect that where faculty deliver a second cycle of the same course, payment will be made for further delivery of the course (25 hours) but not for further design.

Workshops

For external individuals outside the network an honorarium will be offered based on the workshop's duration. We will make one lump sum payment based on our estimated number of hours it would take for the preparation and delivery of the workshop (please see table below). Since the time required for the preparation and delivery of a workshop is similar to what it would be in other spheres of Teach For All, we are not offering monetary compensation for network partner staff members, fellows, or alumni.
