Supporting fellows and alumni from the region to participate in Teach For All's global communities and learning experiences (School Principals, Entrepreneurs, Climate, Education in Emergencies, etc.) so that there is strong representation from the Americas in these global spaces, and they are able to learn with peers from other regions.
Project 4: Manage and process funding applications from alumni in Asia Pacific to Teach For All's Community & Connections Fund	 Project deliverable: review and execute the selection process for funding applications for the Communities & Connections Fund that come from alumni in Asia Pacific, including ensuring funds are distributed and funding reports are shared back with Teach For All from successful applicants. Conducting initial review of new applications and score against selection criteria. Engaging Heads of Alumni, regional team members and Alumni Leadership team in the selection process to gather their input Coordinating with the alumni applicant(s) to help them strengthen their application or rejecting their application with feedback Supporting successful applicants to deliver their projects and share back their impact stories.

The successful candidate will have 8-10 years work experience, including at least 5 years of work experience in the Asia Pacific region. Experience working in multiple country contexts across the region is strongly preferred. Strong ability to build strong, credible relationships with multiple stakeholders to understand their goals and motivations to support collaboration while working virtually and remotely. He or she will demonstrate exceptional strategic thinking abilities with a proven track record of diagnosing and solving complex problems, exercising strong judgement, and working with ambiguity. The successful candidate will also be deeply familiar with and committed to the vision and values of the Teach For All global network, and will have an in-depth understanding of the role that the Teach For All global organisation plays in supporting the network's progress and impact overall.
